


How to Apply for a Wastewater License After Passing an Exam

Licensing for Pollution Abatement Facility Operators (“wastewater operators”) is handled by the Vermont Office of Professional Regulation (OPR). You will need to have an account on OPR’s website. Find more information at <https://sos.vermont.gov/pollution-abatement-facility-operators>

Tips Before Starting Application

You need to score 70% or higher on an exam that is the grade of the license that you are applying for (e.g. score 70% or higher on a Grade 2 Domestic Municipal exam to apply for a Grade 2 Domestic Municipal license).

You will need a copy of your exam results in PDF format. Depending on where you took the exam, you may have received your results by email. Some email provider will let you download the email as a PDF. You may be able to click Print and select “PDF” as the printer, which will allow you to save the email as a PDF. You can also print and scan your results.

In addition to your exam results, you will need to upload the Verification of Employment form as part of the application process. It should be filled out completely and ready to upload before starting the application process.

Applying for a New License

If you do not have a Pollution Abatement Facility Operator license or have a provisional license, you will need to select “Apply for a License” from the left-hand navigation bar.

Upgrading An Existing License (other than provisional license)

To apply for your Pollution Abatement Facility Operator license if you have an existing license that is NOT a provisional license, you will need to log in to your OPR profile and select “Add specialty” to your current license to “upgrade” it to the level exam you have passed.
